Dear Resident,

We are writing to inform you that we are commencing turbine delivery to the Athea wind farm in the week commencing 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2013.

This phase of the wind farm project will take approximately 14 weeks to complete. The works consist of the transportation of the turbine components from Foynes Harbour to the site in Athea. A map of the transport route is contained overleaf. During the transportation period it is expected that there will be an increase in traffic volumes. The turbine components which are exceptionally long loads will be transported with a Garda escort along the transport route between 19.00 hrs and 07.00 hrs.

We have worked with the Gardai, the Roads Department in Limerick County Council and Kerry County Council to develop a Traffic Management Plan. This aims to minimise the effects to traffic travelling along the delivery route.

We kindly ask that you take extra care during this period when using the road. We assure you that we will endeavour to keep disruption to a minimum during the course of the delivery phase.
