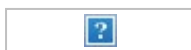

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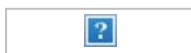

We write on behalf of Keadby Developments Limited ('KDL'), a wholly owned subsidiary of SSE Plc, to consult you on the proposed variation of the Section 36 consent dated 21 December 2017 (the '2017 Consent') for the construction of a gas-fired electricity generating station (the 'Keadby 2 Power Station Project') of up to 910 megawatts ('MW') on land at the existing Keadby Power

Station site, Trentside, Keadby, North Lincolnshire.

The proposed variation will seek minor changes to the 2017 Consent for the Keadby 2 Power Station Project (the 'Project'). The changes will not materially alter the scale of the proposed electricity generating station or its environmental effects as reported within the Environmental Impact Assessment ('EIA') Report dated July 2017 or the Environmental Statement ('ES') dated February 2016.

This letter is accompanied by the following documents (a hard copy has also been sent to you in the post) in order to assist you in considering the proposed variation:

1. Proposed Variation Consent - this is based on the 2017 Consent and shows the changes proposed to the consent in underlined italics.
2. Multi-shaft Layout Plan ref. 105\_0805\_0035\_Rev 02 - this shows the layout of the generating station as proposed to be built.
3. Multi-shaft Elevations (Consented vs Proposed) Plan ref. 105\_0805\_0037\_Rev 00 - this shows the elevations of the main buildings and structures of the generating station as proposed to be built and provides a comparison of these with the 2017 consented plans (the buildings and structures as consented are outlined by the red dashed lines).
4. An update to the EIA Report dated July 2017 (the 'EIA Update Report') - this document considers the proposed changes within the context of the assessment of the environmental effects of the generating station set out in the EIA Report dated July 2017 and the ES for the original variation of the Project dated February 2016.
