Scope of Work

SSE wish to appoint providers to carry out statutory pressure vessel and lifting equipment inspections in compliance with the relevant regulations for a varied number of business areas within the SSE Group, including but not limited to:

- Thermal Generation
- Hydro Generation
- Embedded Generation
- Electrical Contracting
- Electricity Distribution
- Electricity Transmission
- Onshore Wind Generation

This covers the inspection of:

- Lifting Equipment as defined within the Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations 1998
- Pressure Equipment as defined within the Pressure Systems Safety Regulations 2000
- Various items of work equipment covered by the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998
- For inspections in the Republic of Ireland under the applicable legislation the SI 299 of 2007, Safety, Health & Welfare at Work (General Application) Regulations 2007, and Lifting Equipment under the General Application Regulations.

The Employer's requirements are split into the following Lots:

- Lot 1: Corporate covering all UK and Republic of Ireland but excluding Onshore Wind (location of sites shown in 'Map of All Non-Wind Inspection Locations_UK ROI Lot 1')
- Lot2a: Onshore Wind GB (location of sites shown in 'SSE Onshore Wind Locations_lots 2.a and 2.b')
- Lot 2b: Onshore Wind Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland (location of sites shown in 'SSE Onshore Wind Locations_lots 2.a and 2.b')

Size / Volume / Length of Project:

The geographical coverage is UK and Ireland, based on the lot structure detailed under the Scope of Work above.

Anticipated Project / Contract Duration:

Anticipated contract award is July 2020. The duration will be 3 years with 5 x 1 optional extension years.

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Proposed Strategy:

The purpose of this pre-qualification is to identify suitably qualified and experienced contractors to be shortlisted and invited to tender for the works. These tenders will be evaluated on a Most Economically Advantageous Tender basis and the intention is to award one framework per lot.
